The Goal of the Course is to be Living in the Real World. Dr. Kenneth Wapnick

A Course in Miracles makes seventy-seven references to The Real World. What is the Real World?

The publisher of A Course in Miracles is The Foundation for Inner Peace. To be peaceful is to be living in the real world. The real world shows a world seen differently through quiet eyes and with a mind at peace. W-pii.8:2:2 (page 443 in the FIP workbook)

The real world was given to you by God in a loving exchange for the world you made and the world you see. T-12.VIII.8:1

What do you see?

It's all about how we "choose to see" the world and our willingness to accept responsibility for our projections and reactions to the world. What do you see?

Projection makes perception. The world you see is what you gave it, nothing more than that. But though it is no more than that, it is not less. Therefore, to you, it is important. It is the witness to your state of mind, the outside picture of an inward condition. T-21.II.in.1:1-5

Egos Out of Bounds

Turn on the news, and we see a world filled with wars, threats from would-be dictators, and an abundance of egos out of bounds. A study of history is a study of wars. The world we see on the evening news is not where love prevails. Instead, it is a world crying out for love. As it is, it is a world where egos play out a centuries-old, seemingly never-ever-ending, retaliatory game of tit-for-tat and an eye-for-an-eye and a-tooth-for-a-tooth, which, of course, leaves everyone blind and toothless. All the while, Heaven awaits our embrace if we can relinquish the ego's rebellious, insane thinking.

Consider how much vigilance you have been willing to exert to protect your ego and how little you have been willing to expend to protect your higher mind. Who but the insane would undertake to believe what is not true and then protect this belief at the cost of truth? T-4.III.10:1-4

A miracle is a change of mind from misthought, wrong-mindedness, or insanity to mind-fullness, sanity, and rightmindedness. Love "needs" to rule the day. It is the only system of government that will work. We need only bring our minds in line with the Mind of God to see clearly. We need only see it to be it. God is always speaking to all of us all through the day. It's a matter of our willingness to listen.

You must change your mind, not your behavior, and this "is" a matter of willingness. You do not need guidance except at the mind level. Correction belongs only at the level where change is possible. T-2.VI.3:4-6

Amor Fati

Living in the real world requires seeing the world from a higher awakened, non-condemnatory point of view. Around 300 B.C., the Greek philosopher Zeno began teaching a philosophy of life called Stoicism. There are many similarities between Stoicism, Taoism, Zen Buddhism, and the Course. According to Zeno, happiness and peace of mind can be found by living a virtuous life, which is expressed in Amor Fati's—Love of Fate. Practicing a good life through wisdom, willingness, moderation, and justice enables *eudaimonia* (happiness). Amor Fati works well with workbook lesson 268. Let all things be exactly as they are. Love your life the way it is transcending the externals. Do what you can to improve it for others, and you will enrich your life.

Jesus speaking:

I do not attack your ego. I do work with your higher mind, the home of the Holy Spirit, whether you are asleep or awake, just as your ego does with your lower mind, which is its home. T-4.IV.11:1-2

We can never attain good by attacking the world in thought, word, or deed.

The real world cannot be perceived except through eyes forgiveness blesses, so they see a world where terror is impossible, and witnesses to fear cannot be found. W-pii.8.1:4

The first step, the transformation of seeing, is the hardest. We must begin by forgiving ourselves for our insanity. We are being called upon to give up our recalcitrant resistance, stop running away from God, turn around, and go home.

Reason will tell you that the only way to escape from misery is to recognize it "and go the other way." T-22.II.4:1

To do that, we must think like God. How does God think? He does not criticize, attack, or condemn. Instead, He always forgives. He always welcomes us home again. He never holds our evil dream against us.

Jesus' Parable of the Prodigal Son perfectly describes this process. A young man chooses to leave home and go off on his own. The father does not try to stop him as he has free will. He spends all he has and falls into want. When he returns, the father does not mention his waywardness – he is already forgiven. Instead, he says, Bring the best robe and put it on him. Put a ring on his finger and sandals on his feet. (His status is being returned.) Bring the fattened calf and kill it. Let's have a feast and celebrate. For my son was dead and is alive again; he was lost and is found.' Luke 15:22-24

The only thing that matters is that he is safe at home. The only thing that matters is that we, too, wake up and remember that we have been on a nightmare journey. Where we went and what we did, the level of illusion does not matter. The only thing that matters is waking up and realizing we are already home. We never went anywhere.

God knows you "now." He remembers nothing, having always known you exactly as He knows you now. T-15.V.9:1

It is impossible to lose Heaven; We can only sleep and dream we're in a foreign land for a time too short even to remember.

The real world is, but you're welcome to what always was. Therefore, the call of joy is in it, and your glad response is your awakening to what you have not lost. T-13.VII.9:7-8

> The real world is attained simply by the complete forgiveness of the old, the world you see without forgiveness. T-17.II.5:1

Complete forgiveness of the old means holding onto nothing. We need complete forgiveness. Remember,

> The past as well held no mistakes; nothing that did not serve to benefit the world and him to whom it seemed to happen. M-4.VII.1:6

Guilt only points to a land we never want to visit again.

Forgiveness is the call to sanity, for who but the insane would look on sin when he could see the face of Christ instead? And thus is prayer restored to formlessness, beyond all limits into timelessness, with nothing of the past to hold it back from reuniting with the ceaseless song that all creation sings unto its God. S-2.I.8.1&6

The holy relationship, a major step toward the perception of the real world, is learned. It is the old, unholy relationship transformed and seen anew. T-17.V.2:1-2

Behind the chaos that dominates the clouds, the sun still shines. Our world is experiencing an unprecedented spiritual revolution. Older, highly structured, rule-ridden, and ritualized religions are dying. New, more holistic, and interfaith-oriented ways of seeing now become apparent. Science, technology, and spirituality combine in a power surge of refreshing energy, opening doors to more profound and, yet again, deeper levels of seeing, knowing, and being. Let nature take its course says the Stoics, the Zen Buddhist, and the Taoists. That which is untrue dies away from the insidious ingestion of untruth. Only that which stands in the light can grow.

Look at your life and see what the devil (ego) has made. But realize that this making will surely dissolve in the light of truth because its foundation is a lie. T-3.VII.5:3-4

> Remembering is as selective as perception, being its past tense. T-28.I.2:5

The ego would have us review our pains and examine the awful things that happened in the past. All the while, to be free, we could just let it go. Forgive, forget, and go on—looking ever at the rising Son.

The real world still is but a dream. Except the figures have been changed. They are not seen as idols that betray. T-29.IX.7.1-8

Forgiving Dreams

The real world is a dream because the world is a dream, a fantasy, an improvisation we make up as we go along. Think about your childhood for a moment. Does it not now seem like a dream? And what happens after you have let your body go – will this world then not seem like a dream? Something that happened in some distant land – far, far away. For this reason, being lucid dreamers in everyday life is essential to our complete awakening in which, like Jesus, we remember Heaven as our Home.

All your time is spent dreaming. Your sleeping and your waking dreams have different forms, and that is all. T-8.II.5:12

Awakening within the dream, we are less likely to do foolish things, and we dream happy dreams where -- content within ourselves because we do not attack nor take insanity seriously. Instead, we take it as a call for help. When we see a call for help, we help, for by helping others, we help ourselves. According to Principle No. 33 of the 50 Miracles Principles, *Miracles dispel illusions and free us from our nightmares by releasing our minds from the imprisonment of our illusions.* Happy dreams lead us beyond illusion to the truth. Happy dreams are forgiving dreams in which we release the world from our condemnation and forgive ourselves.

Only forgiving dreams can enter here, for time is almost over. And the forms that enter the dream are now perceived as brothers, not in judgment but in love. T-29.IX.7.1-8

As I get older, I'm happy to be carving out more time for stillness and reflection. Many seniors experience this inevitable "cleansing of the ego" in relinquishing what is not needed in favor of the richness of what the moment brings – whether in silence or with friends. We relinquish our investment in the world as we allow the Holy Spirit to extend the real world. Life is simple when we follow the Voice of God. The Holy Spirit has nothing in mind for us that will not bring us the security and peace of mind that comes with knowing God. The Real World is the Holy Spirit's happy dream, the end of the atonement, and the undoing of our thoughts of separation. Living in the real world means living in the now, in the world, in a body free of sin, guilt, and fear. From this perspective, we can experience total forgiveness and the absence of guilt while not taking the world too seriously.

The Higher Mind is a place of heightened awareness. We see what is going on without judgment or condemnation, just as God does. God only loves.

Remember:

The Holy Spirit, like the ego, is a decision. They are the only choices open to you. God created one, and you cannot eradicate it. You made the other, and so you can. T-5.V.6:6-9

Perceiving ONLY the real world will lead you to the real Heaven, because it will make you capable of understanding it. T-11.VII.3:9

Finally,

the doors of Heaven open and we let the dream be gone. Heaven belongs to everyone because it is already ours. Heaven is Here. Heaven is Now. There is no other Place. There is no other time.

The End of Seeking

The Need to Pause to Recognize That We Are What We Are Seeking

Once I was a seeker, looking for books on the shelves of libraries and bookstores, traveling to the Himalayas in Nepal, studying Sanskrit, searching for wisdom in the ashrams in India, sitting with Buddhist monks in Dharamsala, figuring out the meaning of complex



paintings in Tibet and Mongolia, visiting temples in Thailand, Cambodia, Laos, Myanmar, Vietnam, China, Malaysia, Bali, and much more.

The seeking was inspired by the timeless Greek aphorism "know thyself," and by the wisdom displayed by the character Moses in the movie "The Ten Commandments" (1956), which I watched in my teenage years. Back then I was looking for something or some mystical experience that could provide me with a sense of everlasting joy, fulfilment, or meaning. The drive to find answers to the eternal questions that intrigue humanity was part of my life for decades:

Who am I? Where do I come from? What is the purpose of existence? What and where is God? Why do bad things sometimes happen to good people? How to be free from suffering?

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Even witnessing miracles was based on the belief that awakening must be difficult.

Deep down this mind-based seeking for answers, for finding secret teachings, unraveling mysteries, explaining complex esoteric symbols, or even witnessing miracles was based on the belief that awakening must be difficult and come as a result of long years of hard work on oneself. In some circles this difficulty was emphasized, with lifetimes needed to achieve the elusive "enlightenment." Then this passage from *A Course in Miracles* spoke to me:

No one who comes here but must still have hope, some lingering illusion, or some dream that there is something outside of himself that will bring happiness and peace to him. If everything is in him, this cannot be so. [...] And thus he wanders aimlessly about in search of something that he cannot find, believing that he is what he is not. (ACIM-OE, T-29.VII.44-45)

Those last words were the key. While we perceive ourselves as being a separate self that needs to accomplish

something to eventually be able to reconnect with Self or God, the search will continue. And if we believe awakening is really difficult, it is then only for a few.

This belief tends to foster a sense of superiority, of knowing better, or being more awakened, which easily leads to judgment and thus further separation. This became clearer when I heard these words in *A Course of Love*:

You look for explanations and information rather than the truth you claim to seek. You look in judgment rather than in forgiveness. You look from separation's stance rather than from the grace-filled place of union. ... You would like to be a problem solver, a person who could, as in a court of law, separate right from wrong, truth from lies, fact from fiction. You do not even see that what you desire is further separation, and that separation cannot bring about the truth nor arise from unity. (ACOL, C:8.11)



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When it dawns on us that the essence of who we truly are is love, freely available to anyone willing to accept it, and that miracles are simply love's expressions—which often happen in humble moments of daily life rather than in stunning colors that dazzle the mind—the simplicity and ease of the spiritual path leaves the seeking mind confused.

The ego is certain that love is dangerous, and this is always its central teaching. It never puts it this way; on the contrary, everyone who believes that the ego is salvation is intensely engaged in the search for love. Yet the ego, though encouraging the search very actively, makes one proviso—do not find it. Its dictates, then, can be summed up simply as, "Seek and do not find." (ACIM-OE T-11.V.36)

Appealing to the heart and listening to feelings may be most helpful to avoid the pitfalls of becoming an endless seeker. The felt knowing of a "golden age," of a "paradise lost," or of a "Heavenly Father's house," impelling the "prodigal son" to search for a return to a seemingly lost state of being evokes memories that are closer to feelings or longings than to thoughts. That is why music and poetry can evoke powerful memories in us.

Now I see that all this seeking could only provide me with pointers.

This time we take a direct approach, an approach that seems at first to leave behind abstract learning and the complex mechanisms of the mind that so betray you. We take a step away from intellect, the pride of the ego, and approach this final learning through the realm of the heart. (ACOL, C:P.44)

Truth is. It can be neither lost nor sought nor found. It is there, wherever you are, being within you. Yet it can be recognized or unrecognized, real or false to you. (ACIM-OE T-14.IV.25)

Now I see that all this seeking could only provide me with pointers or symbols to that which can only be found or realized when seeking comes to an end. I needed to turn my gaze away from the pointers and toward that which is being pointed to. It's like the imagery of the Buddha's finger pointing to the moon. Somewhere along the journey, we need to turn our attention away from the Buddha or the finger so we can turn it toward the moon.

What is going to be found is that our true identity or Self is an awareness, consciousness, or simply the presence that lies beneath thoughts, feelings, memories, sensory perceptions, and mental impressions. And while being this aware-presence, thoughts, feelings, and so on will continue to arise, we will know experientially that we are not them. Presence will reveal itself to be a spacious, loving awareness that embraces everything. And since it rejects nothing, it is free of any tension or struggle. Peace and love are inherent in it.

For those intent on seeking there is always more to seek, but those who find must stop to realize what

they have found and to realize that they seek no more. (ACOL C:P.23)

Can you let the worries of today leave your mind? Can you let the disappointments of yesterday go and be no more? Can you let the planning for the future cease? Can you be still and know your Self? (ACOL, C:26.16)

Our real Self has never been lost. The awareness of its presence has simply been blocked by the illusory thought of separation. The Self does not seek anything. Seeking is the movement of a mind that still carries the residues of the thought of separation. Thus "finding" merely means relinquishing the belief in separation and accepting the truth of union

In truth there is no return to a place we have



never left. The character Dorothy in "The Wizard of Oz" does not need to return home. In her sleep, she dreams of living in an alien land, searching for a master that can guide her back home, while she is just lying on her bed at home.

This going back is the journey without distance. You need not go in search of it, and in truth, cannot, for the


past does not abide in you. What you need rather do is strive for a place of stillness... (ACOL, C:19.21)

Let us remember together a few lessons from A Course in *Miracles* and A Course of Love:

I am as God created me (94). I am one Self, united with my Creator (95). I am spirit (97). God, being Love, is also happiness (103). I rest in God (109).

I dedicate all thought to union. (C:5.20)

The Sure Path to God

Very early in the revelation of *Choose Only Love*, Jesus tells us that he wants to show us a sure path to happiness and fulfillment. This, in his words, consists of "loving all that arises" in our present human lives. That is, bringing love to all we experience. To leave no room



for doubt, he lists what that "all" means: images, feelings, memories, emotions, thoughts, sensations, etc.

As I received that revelation, I realized that the somewhat exhaustive description of what the "all" means had a clear purpose—to understand in a simple way that the sure path to happiness is to embrace, honor, integrate, and love every aspect of our humanity in every moment. This is not a simple description of one spiritual path among many. It is, rather, the hallmark of "The New."

In The Age of the Heart, the voice of Christ says that feelings and everything that concerns the heart, including intuition, are finally going to be honored—that is, integrated into our individual consciousness in order to unite our divinity with our humanity.

Ultimately, union means the union of body and spirit, humanity and divinity, Heaven and Earth, time and eternity, the abstract and the concrete. It makes sense, at least to me, for if the new is a state of union, it is necessary that it begin by reuniting what is closest to us: ourselves.

According to the revelation received from Jesus, the new will always have the charisma of an embodied spirituality, that is, one in which our "human self," with all the nuances that

human experience entails, is integrated, accepted, blessed, included, and loved. And as an effect of this, all is transmuted into perfect love.

How else can I integrate, accept, bless, include, and love others and everything else if I do not do so with all that I am in each present moment? Is it possible to love all things if I do not love myself in all that I am, without leaving any of my humanity aside?

I share these questions because they help me to visualize the path. And I feel that perhaps they can help others as well. When asked consciously, they act in me as signposts to the truth of what the incarnation of Christ in each of us means. They remind me of what I am: the living Christ who lives in me—human-God, body-spirit, Earth-sky, the part and the whole. I am one—first with all that I am being, and then with all else. In that order.

Our humanness, with all that it entails, is an expression in form of formless spirit.

Spirituality with a body is spirituality "from below," one in which our earthliness is intrinsically linked to our heavenliness. The revelation tells us that our humanness, with all that it entails, is an expression in form of formless spirit, which is why it is worthy of being loved, honored, and respected as sacred. This includes every thought, emotion, sensation, and all the many other things that are part of the holy humanity that we are.



The knowledge I share here has led me to become aware of the multiple mechanisms that we so often use as individuals and as a universal family to "spiritually by-pass"—that is, the tendency to use spiritual ideas and practices to sidestep or avoid facing unresolved emotional issues, psychological wounds, and unfinished developmental tasks, both individually and collectively.

Spirituality is not the only thing that can serve to "bypass" our present human experience. Entertainment, work, addictions, relationships, and much more can have the same purpose: to avoid connecting with the heart and instead attaining an "ideal self" which may seem very beautiful, holy, and elevated, but will never be real and therefore true. Consequently it will not be the holy expression of the love that we are.

Our Divine Mother tells us that we cannot love what we do not see, if we do not love what we do see.

Isn't the mechanism of "spiritual bypass" a way of denying who we are? Let us connect this with the statement that our Divine Mother gives us when she tells us that we cannot love what we do not see, if we do not love what we do see. And what else do we see first but our present human experience?

When we speak of spiritual bypass, we are talking about a spirituality "from above"—one that totally or partially denies our humanity by not lovingly embracing and integrating it as it is right now, in each present moment. This can be accomplished not only through practices, rituals, and belief systems, but also in spiritual communities.

Throughout history there have been, and continue to be, many "religious" or "spiritual" groups whose goal is, essentially, to withdraw from or overcome the world by

reinforcing a feeling of religious identity. There are also other types of withdrawal. Although withdrawal may have the intention of not leaving aside our divine aspect, it often ends up generating a state of dissociation, a condition of division and exclusion, which finally becomes a lack of love.

In short, trying to escape from what is not necessary or possible—from the varied human experience—leads us to continue living in a state of separation, which is far from love. This is why, as our Divine Mother tells us in one of the dialogues, that a spirituality based on the firm rock of truth and love is one in which one lives with one's eyes on Heaven and one's feet on the ground.

Spirituality "from below" honors life as it is here and now in all its forms of expression, without judging anything but loving everything and everyone, without excluding anything, but embracing all—all—ALL!—in the love we are. Giving space to what is, just as it is. Without pretending it to be different.

A spirituality like this allows each of us to be fully as we are without trying to be an ideal self not based on reality one in which humanity is finally recognized as the holiness, beauty, and magnificence it truly is. This is, to a large extent, the path of the new. I feel that when A Course of Love that tells us that the new is love extending into creation, it is referring to some degree to what is shared here.

Accordingly, I now understand the following: it is by loving everything that arises in me, allowing everything I feel, think, and experience to show me the truth of what I am, that the incarnate Christ manifests from me in all its glory,



beauty, and holiness. And by doing so, I live in the happiness and fullness of the children of God, which consists of being as we were created to be—the embodied Christ.

This understanding is what I wish to share with you, my dear reader, with all my heart. I do so in the hope that together we will remember again the beauty of our humanity and of all living beings as they are. And in this way unite Heaven and Earth.



Oⁿ May 13th, 2024, I had a dream about what I believe was a past life I had back in the 1870s. My name was Emmaline Fischer. I lived on a cattle ranch with my parents in the southwestern U.S. I was the eldest of four children.

Whenever I would wave hello or greet him in any way, instead of waving to me, he would close his fist and lightly touch it twice to his heart. I decided that if he was just joking, that was fine. But if he was serious, there was no way he'd ever have me. I had plans to move to a big city as soon as I was old enough and find myself a well-to-do business man to whisk me away from ranch life.

It was then that my dream shifted and flitted through all the many moments that Burton had done his "heart beat" gesture. We'd had this exchange so many times that it was often comical. Once his arms were full of tools and all he could do was squeeze the grease can two pumps and got some on the ground. I found the sight hilarious. Another time he was holding dusty rags and beat his fist against his chest, releasing an plume of dirt and dust which caused us both to burst out laughing.

Over the next 2 to 3 years, this gesture came to be "our thing." I didn't give it much thought other than that Burton was a kind man.

When I turned 19, against my parent's advice I left to go find my dreams and a "well-to-do business man" in the big city. Or at least I tried to.

I was back in just over 8 months. The city was not what I had expected, and neither were the business men. Nothing was as I'd hoped, and I soon found I missed the peace and quiet of the ranch and our simple routines. The work was hard but satisfying.

A few days after I'd returned, I was standing on a low hill overlooking the cattle pasture. There down below, was Burton, his back to me, pumping water into the cattle trough.

I realized I'd never really taken a good look at him. He was a giant of a man, easily 6 foot 5 inches tall, with broad shoulders and a lean frame. I never really thought of him as either good or bad looking one way or the other, but now I realized he was quite handsome. He was 6 years older than me; I was 20. I now looked at him through more mature eyes.

I also realized he was rare among men, nothing like the city men I'd met. He was filled with the depth and strength of a life of hard physical work, and that builds character.

I also had always thought of him as perhaps a bit uneducated or lacking in intelligence, but now I thought about how we always knew that when Burton had fixed or built something, it was done to perfection. He took pride in everything he did and did it to the best of his ability no matter how small the task. I realized he wasn't unintelligent, he was just a quiet person who mainly kept to himself.

I also thought about how kind he was to the farm animals, and the extra care he gave them, ensuring they had enough food, water, and shelter. His primary concern was always their comfort.

Burton was a kind and good man in every way, and my heart swelled with love for him. I realized that I'd never really seen him for who he truly was.

And I finally saw that he had loved me for years, but I could never see it because my mind was made up with plans for a future of my own design. I marveled at his patience and respect for me.

It was then that I went down to him and stood silently behind him while he continued pumping the well handle, filling the stock tank. At last he turned around and saw me standing there, and said, "Well, hello there, you! What can I do for you?"

I didn't say a word but took two steps towards him, closing the gap between us and wrapped him in my arms in the most loving hug I had ever given anyone. He hesitantly but happily returned the hug. I had never done such a thing before, and he was slightly confused by my actions.

I then turned the hug into a deep kiss. And I could feel shock and disbelief reverberate throughout his entire being.

After a few moments he pulled slightly away from my face to look into my eyes and softly said in his deep, gentle voice, "I thought this day would never come."

And I replied, "It is here, and I'm never going to leave your side."

With that I woke up.

My first thought upon waking was, "What a dream!" I knew instantly that it was from a past life and could feel the sameness of the energy of Burton to my present-day husband, and knew they were one and the same. He and I had clearly spent this past life together.

Such dreams do not come for no reason. There is always something to be learned or understood more deeply.

That morning, as I turned to my daily Workbook lesson in *A Course In Miracles*, I had my answer. The lesson was #135: If I Defend Myself I Am Attacked.

That lesson was always difficult for me to understand on a deep level. I mean, of course I'm attacked if I defend myself; I'm being attacked! However, it took on new meaning in light of the past life dream.

As I read it again, it became extremely clear that one of our ego's "defenses" against the truth of our unity and perfection in God was to make future plans. We are "defending" against the truth when we make future plans. In essence, we are saying that God is wrong—we are not safe and must make our own separate plans for our future happiness. The lesson now made perfect sense. Here are a few lines from lesson 135 read in this way:

- Defense (making our own plans) is frightening. It stems from fear, increasing fear as each defense (plan) is made.
 You think it offers safety. Yet it speaks of fear made real and terror justified."
- A healed mind does not plan. It carries out the plans that it receives through listening to Wisdom that is not its own. It waits until it has been taught what should be done, and then proceeds to do it.
- The mind engaged in planning for itself is occupied in setting up control of future happenings. It does not

think that it will be provided for, unless it makes its own provisions.

Your present trust in Him is the defense (the plan) that promises a future undisturbed, without a trace of sorrow, and with joy that constantly increases, as this life becomes a holy instant, set in time, but heeding only immortality.

In my past life experience I had tried to make my own future plans, or defenses. What I hadn't realized until I returned was that I needn't have made any plans at all. My own plans were not in my best interests. And I nearly missed the even better, much happier plans that were already laid before me by a Higher Power.

Isn't that what we're doing here now, in this earthly life? Haven't we "left" or forgotten our Oneness in God, thinking we can find something better, apart from Him? This lesson from *A Course In Miracles* asks that we practice trust and faith in the truth of our Oneness. And in this way, the unseen can become the seen, and the best plan ever laid before us can become manifest.

A Measuring Stick for Spiritual Progress

We understand the importance of not being invested in having the external form of a problem change, but why is it that sometimes there is a corresponding external change and sometimes there isn't?



Maybe the value of the lesson is that the form does not change. To evaluate the content by the form is a very common and extremely easy trap to follow fall into.

Why assume that if we identify with the Holy Spirit's love, that everything should be better on the outside? And if it's not, we begin to doubt it. What if the most loving thing is for things not to get better on the outside? This can be easily understood when we have our Atonement path to consider. Imagine Jesus' path for example; crucifixion is not exactly a nice reflection in the dream, but obviously for him, this was in his Atonement path.

Perfect love cannot be changed in any way or affected by what happens outside. That's why it's perfect. If everything ends up looking wonderful, then what value lies in the lessons? Sure, guilt can cause "non-favorable" circumstances in the world, and thus the undoing of the guilt can, therefore, undo the need for those parts of the script. But we can't always evaluate what the changes are, what they should be.

We do not perceive our own best interests. We want to be happy, have good health, good work conditions, happy family, and lots of money, but what if that is not in our best interest? It can be. But what if it's not? We can't judge this. What we can do however, is go to the right-mind that is totally independent of these factors. Its light shines through no matter what occurs.

We clearly believe that the peace of God is not affected by outside circumstances, so why do we demand these changes and use them as a measuring stick for our progress? Everything can be used to help us learn God's lessons. Workbook lesson 193 says, "All things are lessons God would have me learn. He would not leave an unforgiving thought without correction, nor one thorn or nail to hurt His holy Son in any way." (W-193.9:1-2).

Our investment in perfecting our dream (our specialness needs) is what has us tell God that we can do it better without Him. And so, if our dream "aspirations" fail, it means God could be better than our specialness. Maybe there's something else worth striving for?

This is also why we fight so hard to protect our dream having it stay the way we like it—so we don't get in touch with this. This explains our investment, our tremendous need to have our perfect world and body free from God. Hence, the Course says that we made this world as a literal attack on God.

We are so scared of the horrifying thought that tells us that we are wrong. We can't stand that. Thus, it doesn't matter how many times our attempts have failed us, we still desperately try to make it better again. It can never work because it's set up not to work. How so? Because it's all based on egoic perception which can never be true. To be more specific, the Son of God is guilty, so everything He does must fail.

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The ego is the attempt to have you believe that love can be destroyed.

The whole focus of the Course has nothing to do with trying to change anything in the world. This whole purpose is to teach us not to do that because it's futile. Nothing here can be equal to or replace the Kingdom of Heaven. Everything else is valueless.

We shouldn't use anything in the world as a measuring stick for spiritual progress because the Son of God cannot be subjected to a fantasy. Our choice is easy; we either reaffirm that we are the Son of God, or say that the ego is stronger than Reality. The Peace of God can be there no matter the body's condition.

Jesus' crucifixion was a teaching lesson. It was a way of teaching the disciples that his body can be riddled with sickness and cancer, etc., but he is just as loving and just as peaceful as he was before. It's a way of saying our sins have no effect and whatever it is that is going on around me has no effect on me.

We can demonstrate that it's possible for people to be in what the world judges to be a painful state and feel no pain. We can still be loving and peaceful and say this doesn't matter now. You could destroy the body, but you can't destroy love. The ego is the attempt to have you believe that love can be destroyed. Don't affirm that belief. Expose the lie for what it is. Hence, we have death. But love cannot be affected by bodily death. You can still have relationships with people who died. Everything is in the mind.

The message of the Holy Spirit is nothing has happened so why idolize form? "What lives is holy as Himself, because what shares His life is part of Holiness, and could no more be sinful than the sun could choose to be of ice; the sea elect to be



apart from water, or the grass to grow with roots suspended in the air." (W-156.3:3).

The Course asks us to remember that love cannot be changed or affected by what happens to the body. If we learn this lesson with one

particular person, we can eventually generalize it to others, which then leads to the realization that God has not been affected.

In a recent "Sunday With Mundy" event, Jon Mundy interviewed Glenn Hovemann, publisher of *A Course of Love*, and his wife Muffy Weaver. Mr. Hovemann's observations about *A Course of Love* (ACOL) stayed with me after the interview concluded. He stated



there are no ACOL teachers and pointed out that there are no lessons, no Workbook, in ACOL. The reason is simple—there is nothing we need to learn. As Jesus says in ACOL, the time of learning is over. Now is the time for Being. It's the time for Being You, and You Are Love – through and through. You can't teach what you already are.

tomorrow, and it may show up several generations later, as measured by time. Time, as we know, is an illusion, after all.


